Zakat and Sadqaats Collection

Members also donated large quantity of food items such as dates during the month of Ramadan. The process of Zakat and Sadqa

collection is transparent and record is being maintained and shared at every step in the forum.





Tree Plantation Drive

We believe that natural resources are best protected and positively utilized when community plays an active role in their care and management. AJK department of forest under the umbrella of (Billion Trees Tsunami) donated 150 plants of Deodar to Banjosa village. Mr Zahid Ishaq Khan and Mr Javed Akhter also donated 800 plants of Deodar (Cedar) and Thuja. The purpose of this drive was to make the environment cleaner, beatification and create awareness about environmental issues such as deforestation, erosion of soil etc. The civil society and people from all walks of life, specially students took part in the drive and planted trees at different locations including schools, graveyards and by the road side. Our profound gratitude to DFO Reforestation Sardar Muhammad Latif Khan for donating plants.





Health-Fund Raising

One of the objectives of Banjosa Development Council is to help spread awareness about how to maintain good health, how to prevent spread of virus and how to safeguard our loved ones from getting infected? For this purpose BDC utilized social media, personal communication and mosques to spread the message. BDC on advice of doctors also launched a campaign which resulted in generating considerable amount of funds to be utilized for prevention and subsequently treatment of covid-19 patients in the village. Mr. Muhammad Qari Khalil remained at the forefront of the idea and helped to generate funds also purchased oximeter, oxygen concentrator, masks and sanitizers. Mr. Khizar Havat from Canada also donated 4 oximeters apart from donating a handsome amount in health fund. The total collection in health fund remains Rs 448436 and donated equipment includes one oxygen cylinder, one Oxygen concentrator and three oximeters. The fund will be utilized to purchase health related equipment during this CORONA pandemic. So far one oxygen concentrator and other Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) has been purchased from this fund. Five oxygen cylinders of RHC (Rural Health center) Banjosa have been refilled by the BDC and 15 liters of sanitizer is placed at public places for use, such as mosques, bazars and public transport.










Photography Competition
